



## **Resolution No. 10 – 02**

### **Alberta Long Service Recognition Medal and 30 Year Long Service Bar**

**WHEREAS** Emergency Services personnel are recognized and awarded Long Service Medals by the Province for their commitment and dedication to their professions; and,

**WHEREAS** Police Officers receive their APOLSRM after 25 years of service and all other Emergency Services receive their medals in 20 years or less; and,

**WHEREAS** Peace officers within the Province of Alberta receive the Peace Officer Long Service Recognition Medal after 20 years' of service.

#### **NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT**

The Alberta Association of Chiefs of Police requests the Solicitor General change the qualifying period of service for the APOLSRM from the current 25 years' service to 20 years to align with the Peace Officer Long Service Recognition Medal; and,

#### **AND FURTHER BE IT RESOLVED THAT**

In keeping with the standard set by the Federal Police Exemplary Service Medal, that a 30 year bar be added to the APOLSRM upon the recipient achieving 30 years of service to the province.
