



Resolution No. 10 – 05

INTRODUCE MISSING PERSONS LEGISLATION

WHEREAS Alberta does not have missing persons legislation; and,

WHEREAS police are not able to conduct a thorough investigation upon receipt of a missing persons report, due to restricted access to information and property; and,

WHEREAS this impedes investigators in determining the status and possibly the location of missing persons; and,

WHEREAS this legislation exists and is effective in other provinces.

NOW THEREFORE LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT

The Alberta Association of Chiefs of Police urge the Provincial Government to introduce a Missing Persons Statute, allowing police services judicially approved access to records and property of missing persons for investigative purposes.
